

OCTOBER NEWSLETTER NURSERY CLASSES

The first couple weeks of school have gone by quickly and October is here already. It is nice to welcome fall. We packed a lot of fun and learning into September with our bug unit. The children are settling into the routines of school and making new friends. School is a comfortable and happy place for most of the children already.

This month the children will be working on an “All About Me” book for the first two weeks of October. We will be saving the work that your child does in school to be included in this book. Therefore, no work will be coming home for those two weeks. It will be worth the wait!

Our first field trip is coming up this month. We will be going to Indian Acres on October 21. The farm is right on Tuckerton Road, across from Barton Run. We will meet at the farm at 11:00 – both AM and PM classes will attend at this time. We will be done at 12:30 for pick up. Parents are invited to accompany their child on this outing. The trip includes an informative talk, a hayride, pumpkin picking, and a picnic lunch. You may order lunch on the permission slip, this includes a hot dog, bag of chips, and a juice box. The cost for the trip is included on the permission slip that will come home in your child’s backpack. Please turn the slip and money in by October 18. Please note that a check is requested.

October 5 is picture day at school. Kovatch Photography will be taking individual and cubby pictures. An envelope will be sent home, in which you should return the cash or check made out to Kovatch Photography. The package price and the packages available to order are explained on the sheet accompanying the Kovatch envelope.

Please indicate what you want on the envelope and turn in your envelope by September 30. No one is obligated to purchase anything. Your child’s picture will be taken as part of the cubby even if you do not purchase pictures. Our Halloween celebration will be on October 28. *The children should come to school in costume at the normal start time.* Parents are invited to go to Bowker Hall after dropping off their children to watch our costume parade. This will be brief. Afterwards we will change the children out of their costumes, so please send in a bag or you can help them and then take the costume home with you. Some children are frightened and choose not to wear a costume, this is fine. Our themes for the month will be ALL ABOUT ME, PUMPKINS, APPLES, and HALLOWEEN.
